**Burbank HealthCare Foundation Presents \$100,000  
To Burbank Partners in Education**

(Burbank, CA) Board members Sunder Ramani and Randy Stevenson, representing the Burbank Health Care Foundation, presented a check of \$100,000 to the Burbank Partnership In Education at the Burbank City Council meeting on December 18, 2008.

The gift is the first payment towards fulfilling a two-year, \$200,000 commitment from the Foundation to support construction of a new track and athletic field at Burbank and Boroughs High Schools. “We are proud to be a significant contributor to the ongoing good health of Burbank,” commented Mr. Ramani. “We look forward to seeing the project completed and the tracks in use not only by the high school students but also by the community at large as convenient venues for walking, running and keeping fit.”

When the announcement was made that public support would be needed to fully fund the upgrades of the tracks and fields at the local high schools, the Burbank Health Care Foundation moved the project forward by making the first major contribution. To recognize the Foundation’s early and generous support, the Burbank Unified School District will be embedding the Foundation’s logo in the running tracks.
